#### C.U.P.E. Local Union #1119 Bursary

Value \$200. – Awarded to a graduate of TVHS, preference given to a son/daughter of Local Union #1119 member. Payable after first semester completed. Confirmation of enrollment

#### **C.U.P.E.** # 4445 (Manor)

Value \$100.00 - Awarded to a graduate of TVHS, preference given to son/daughter of Local Union #4445Member. Payable after first semester completed. Confirmation of enrollment.

#### In Memorial\* - The Anderson – Doucette Memorial Scholarship

Value: \$1000. Criteria: Preference given to a career in the field of Health Care or Engineering in a University or College. Scholastic standing; financial need; upstanding character traits and work ethic, brief summary of your school activities extracurricular, clubs, hobbies and community service.

In Memorial\* - Benoit Levesque Scholarship Value: \$200.00 Criteria: Not in receipt of Criteria: Not in receipt of any other scholarship, attending any Post-Secondary School and a written letter why you are the deserving student of scholarship including community involvement. Confirmation of second semester.

#### In Memorial \* Betty and Cliff Spicer Scholarship

**Criteria**: Attending a post-secondary institution, financial need, scholastic standing and character. Confirmation of enrollment at beginning of second year or completion of program is required.

#### <u>In Memorial\* Carleton-Victoria Liberal Association</u> (In memory of Julie Goodine)

Criteria: Summary of future plans, extracurricular and community involvement required. Confirmation of enrolment second semester.

#### In Memorial\* David Ashworth Scholarship

Value: \$1000. Criteria: Graduate of TVHS. Entering a trade. Accompanied by a written summary outlining future plans, extracurricular and community involvement and personality/character strengths.

#### <u>In Memorial \* Elsie Hathaway Memorial Scholarship</u>

Value TBA at Graduation – Basis of qualification: High mark in Modern History; scholastic standing; financial need; personality; character; stability. Confirmation of enrolment second semester required. **Typed summary** of history of Elsie Hathaway.

#### In Memorial\* Jamie Paris Memorial Bursary

Value TBA at Graduation – Qualifications are scholastic standing; financial need, personality; character; work ethic, and involvement in community/extra-curricular activities. Also <u>include a one-page letter</u> with description outlining your involvement in the community (sports, volunteer activities, jobs, etc. Transcript is requested. Confirmation of registration in second semester from the institution is required.

#### In Memorial \* Kaylee Eccleston-Green Memorial Turn Around Award

**Value** up to \$500. **Write a paragraph** or two explaining Academic Turn-Around Achievements.

#### In Memorial\* - Laureen Holt Memorial Bursary (founder of Mama Bear)

**Value** \$500. **Criteria**: Must be pursuing a career in the Health Field and/or been personally affected by Cancer. Write **short essay** on why you have chosen a career in health field and/or how Cancer has personally affected your life.

#### In Memorial \* Lloyd and Kathleen Morton Memorial Scholarship

Value \$250. Criteria: Financial need and academic merit also a <u>written</u> <u>summary</u> outlining your future plans, extra-curricular and community involvement and personality/character strengths. Confirmation of enrolment in second semester.

#### Michael Jarvis Memorial Scholarship

**Value:** \$1000. **Criteria:** University or College - Must be accompanied with an <u>essay</u> outlining community involvement and volunteer efforts. Reference from supervisor re your volunteer efforts; transcript; good academic standing

#### In Memorial\* Molly (Sadler) Ashworth Memorial Scholarship

**Value**: \$250. – **Criteria**: academic merit and involvement in extracurricular activities (school/community organized athletics or clubs, community volunteerism, etc). Preference to those entering health or agriculture industries. **Include a one-page hand-written essay** outlining your extracurricular involvement and future plans. Confirmation of enrolment in second semester

#### In Memorial\* Pat Paget Memorial Bursary

**Value** \$250. – **Criteria**: preference given to student entering an Arts or Education program; scholastic standing; financial need; personality; character; stability. Confirmation of registration for second semester.

#### In Memorial\* - Russel and Sandra Bradford Scholarship

**Value:** \$500. **Criteria:** Awarded to a student that displays community spirit, involvement in community volunteered activities such as: member of golf/curling, active sports and organized community clubs. Preference will be given to applicants who volunteer for World Pond Hockey Championships. A **letter of reference** from someone within the organization confirming your level of participation as well as outlining your community service. This must be accompanied with the application. Confirmation of second semester.

#### In Memorial\* Shirley Paget Memorial Bursary

**Value** \$250. – **Criteria**: Preference given to student entering an Arts or Education program; scholastic standing; financial need; personality; character; stability. Confirmation of registration for second semester.

#### <u>In Memorial \* – Tamara McDougall Scholarship</u>

**Value** \$200.00 – Basis of qualification: excelled in French at high school level and continuing post-secondary courses in French. Financial need. Confirmation of registration of second semester.

#### In Memorial\* - Wilda Neilson Scholarship

**Value:** \$1000. **Criteria**: Must be accompanied with a **typed summary** outlining candidate's future plans, extra-curricular and community involvement, personality/character strengths.

#### David L. Michaud Trades Scholarship

<u>Value</u>: up to \$1,000. Criteria: Attending NBCC in any of the Apprenticeable Trades including the 2-year Skilled Trades Techniques Program. <u>Written summary</u> including interest in the trade selected, future career plans, personality/character strengths and how funds will help you achieve your goals.

#### NBTA BRANCH 1431 Scholarship

**Value** \$250. —Graduating child of a branch 1431 member entering post secondary institution. Include a short **written report** indicting why you should be the successful candidate, considering the selection criteria. Scholastic standing; volunteerism; school & community engagement; leadership. Two letters of recommendation one from a teacher (non family) who taught you in grade 11 or 12 and one from a community member (non family).

#### **New Denmark Recreational Council**

Value \$150. – Scholastic standing in HPE 110. Athletic ability, New Denmark student graduating at T.V.H.S. <u>Letter of reference required from HPE 110 teacher or coach</u>. Payable second term with confirmation of enrollment. MUST have a standing membership with the New Denmark Recreational Council.

#### Order of Easter Star - Lottie L. Kyle Memorial Scholarship

Must be a son or daughter of an Eastern Star Member.

#### **Tyler Shirley Memorial Bursary**

**Value** \$500.00 – **Criteria:** self-motivated, reliable, interest in community, good moral character and continuing education/training. Confirmation of registration from institute

#### Plaster Rock SummerFest Scholarship

<u>Value</u>: \$250. Applicant must be a local student with accomplished community involvement, volunteered within the community or a specific group. The need for financial assistance and acceptance into a post-secondary institution is also required. A 150-200 word <u>essay</u> describing your community involvement and/or volunteer work as well as any other reasons why you feel you would be a successful candidate for this scholarship is required.

#### **Plaster Rock United Baptist Church**

Value \$100. Graduate of TVHS; written summary outlining future plans; personality/character strengths; financial need will be a basis for qualification.

#### **Royal Canadian Legion, Arthurette Branch #85**

**Bursaries** @ \$100.00 each – Must be a child/grandchild of a member. Based on financial need and scholastic standing. Proof of eligibility to enter course must be supplied to receive money.

#### Royal Canadian Legion, Marble Arch Branch #29 (Plaster Rock)

**Value**: 2 @ \$300.00 – applicant must be a son/daughter <u>or</u> grandchild of regular member, resident of Plaster Rock School District. <u>Must show military relationship</u> and name profession or trade for which money will be used.

#### Sisson Brook Women's Institute

**Value** \$200.00 – **Criteria:** Scholastic standing, financial need, son or daughter of member given first opportunity, but open to other students.

#### Sisson Ridge Women's Institute Bursary

Value: 2 @ \$100 each.

**Criteria**: Applicants are to have **three references** with names and addresses on application. This bursary will be awarded to a graduate of TVHS that is accepted into a post-secondary institution. Confirmation of second semester is required.

#### **Tobique Lions Club Scholarship**

**Value**: \$300.00 – Must be entering an institution other than a university. Basis is scholastic standing, financial need, personality, character and stability.

#### Tobique Lodge No. 48 F & AM (Masonic Lodge)

**Value** \$200. – Basis for qualification, scholarship standing, financial need, personality, character, stability. Payable after first semester completed.

#### **Tobique Valley Health Care Foundation Scholarship**

**Value:** \$1000.

Good academic standing and plan to study in the field of <u>health care</u>. Include <u>transcript</u>, <u>brief essay</u> outlining future plans and reason for choosing this field. List your personal accomplishments, including extra-curricular activities and community involvement. Payable after first semester completed.

#### **Tobique Valley High School Student Council**

**Value** \$200.00 – Basis is marks during final year, attitude in school, financial need. Confirmation of second semester enrollment required

#### **Tobique Valley Manor Auxiliary Bursary**

**Value** \$200.00 – Basis of qualification: Son or daughter of a resident or staff member; scholastic standing in final year; financial need; community involvement. Confirmation of second semester registration from institute.

#### **Tobique Valley Minor Soccer Scholarship**

<u>Value:</u> \$200. - Criteria – Leadership - Demonstrates consistent and outstanding dedication to making their community a better place. Preference given to a student who has coached youth soccer, but other coaching, mentoring experiences will be considered. Attach an <u>essay</u> of 300-500 words on what you feel are the benefits of youth volunteers in the community. Confirmation of enrolment in second semester.

#### **United Church Women's Group Scholarship**

**Value:** \$200. – <u>Written summary</u> outlining your future plans and personality/character strengths. Financial need will be a basis for qualifications.

#### World Pond Hockey Championship Inc. TVHS Bursary

**Value** \$1,000. – Basis of qualification: Community service, scholastic standing, athletic participation and **Essay to be written**.
